## IPSF Milestones & Accomplishments

IPSF strives to unite the community in support of educational excellence, and this year was yet another illustration of the power of collaboration and partnership.

Contributions from parents, community, and corporate partners make our work possible. Thank you for your generous support and dedication to the students of Irvine. Together, we have put more teachers in Irvine classrooms, preserved music and STEM programs, and ensured our schools are centers of innovation. Because of you, more than 34,000 students have opportunities to explore, learn and grow in ways that would not otherwise be possible.

With your help, in 2016-17 IPSF:

- Ranked #3 in the nation and #1 in California amongst K-12 education foundations by *Stepping Up: The Nation's Top K-12 Education Foundations*.
- Donated over \$5.5 million to IUSD in IPSF grants, donations and program services.
- Continued our annual commitment to IUSD by supporting fundamental initiatives including small learning groups, music, STEM, and health and wellness.
- Awarded more than \$325,000 in grants to teachers for innovative teaching and counseling methods through our Innovative Grants Program.
- Expanded enrollment in Summer Enrichment Academy K-12 by 20%.
- Kicked off the second mission of the Irvine CubeSat STEM Program, Irvine02, which was selected by NASA as one of 32 organizations nationwide to participate in a future launch mission.



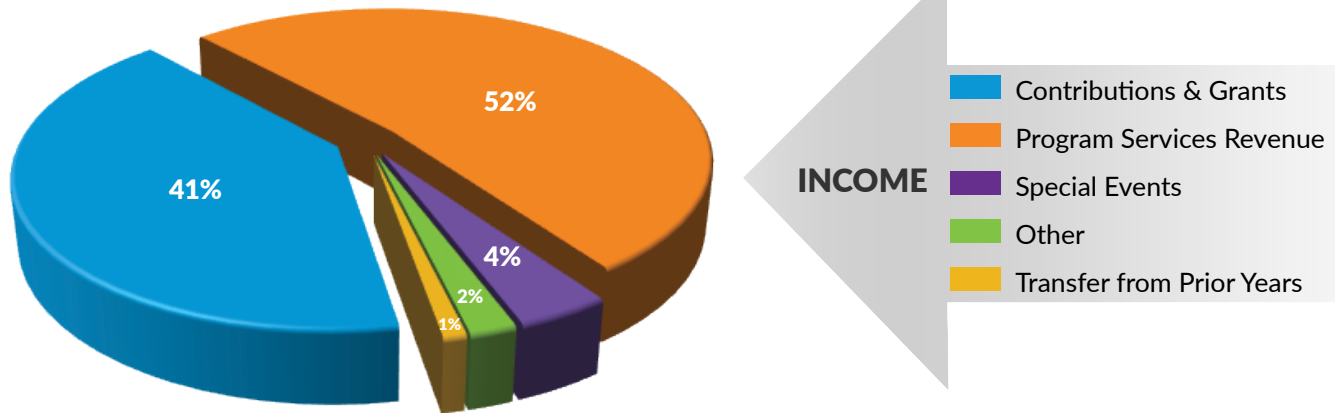

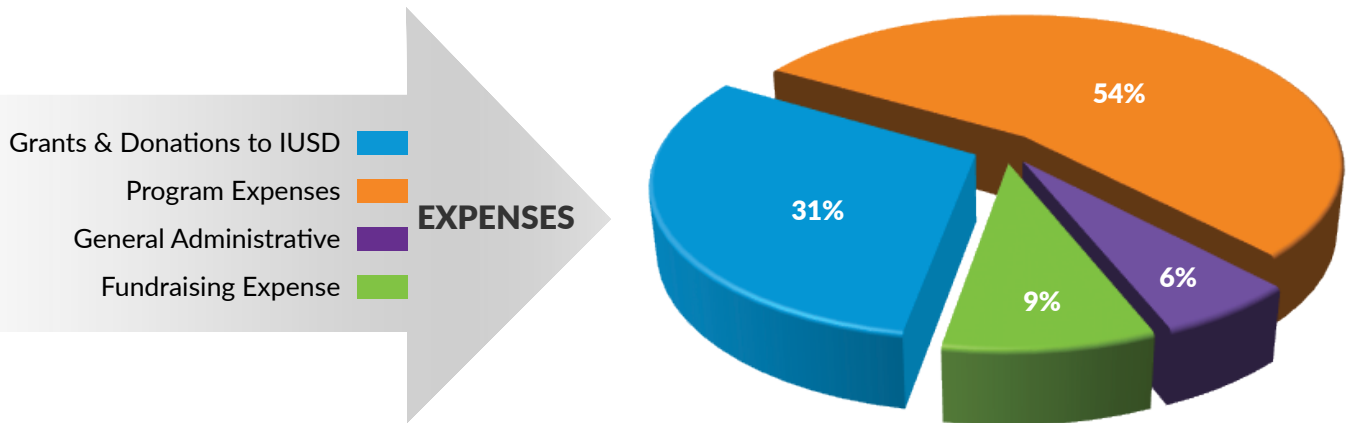
# 2016 | 17 Financial Report

## INNOVATION IN ACTION

### *Irvine CubeSat Continues To Reach New Heights*

The inaugural year of the Irvine CubeSat STEM Program was met with many successful milestones for more than 150 students involved from the six Irvine high schools. The first mission, Irvine01, is ready for launch, and awaiting take off at the launch provider in India in 2018. Irvine02 is reaching completion, and was one of 34 small satellites nationwide selected to participate in NASA's CubeSat Launch Initiative and fly on their 2018 mission. Irvine CubeSat is one of only two high schools chosen by NASA to participate in this prestigious program, alongside renowned universities and research centers.

Irvine02 is designed to teach optical communications, transferring data at a faster rate than radio from orbit to Irvine. Irvine CubeSat is currently collaborating with Irvine Valley College to procure and install a new set of electronics for their large satellite dish atop the IVC library. If successful, the dish will be able to receive the beacon from 01 and 02, leading to full command and control of 03 and later CubeSats, providing students with additional opportunities to be involved in every aspect of the mission.

### *Kindergarteners In Motion*

In 2017, Deerfield Elementary was awarded one of IPSF's \$20,000 Mega Innovative Grants for their Kindergarten team to implement their project called Flipping PE. The team was looking for a solution to increase student concentration, focus, gross motor skills, brain function, and behavior in their young learners. The grant allowed them to purchase new furniture that provides students with the opportunity to choose from a variety of kinesthetic seating options - including minion chairs, pedal desks, and wobble chairs - and the results have been remarkable.



"It is incredibly beneficial for students to move and wiggle while learning," explains teacher Karen Whippo. "This furniture has been so successful in helping our students maintain focus, enjoy learning, and improve muscle development. I have a student with muscle strength issues, and after just 30 days of school, I noticed an improvement in his posture, ability to maintain balance, and ability to sit upright on his carpet square."
