## IPSF Milestones & Accomplishments

IPSF strives to unite the community in support of educational excellence, and this year was yet another illustration of the power of collaboration and partnership.

Contributions from parents, community, and corporate partners make our work possible. Thank you for your generous support and dedication to the students of Irvine. Together, we have put more teachers in Irvine classrooms, preserved music and STEM programs, and ensured our schools are centers of innovation. Because of you, more than 35,000 students have opportunities to explore, learn and grow in ways that would not otherwise be possible.

With your help, in 2017-18 IPSF:

- Was ranked the #3 education foundation in the nation and awarded Nonprofit of the Year by the Greater Irvine Chamber of Commerce.
- Awarded more than \$160,000 in grants to teachers for innovative teaching and counseling methods through our Innovative Grants Program.
- Partnered with students from all five high schools to present Irvine Talks, an event to bring the community together through student created stories, art, music, and immersive performances to celebrate and explore what it means to be human.
- Kicked off the third mission of the Irvine CubeSat STEM Program, Irvine03, which was selected by NASA as one of 34 organizations nationwide to participate in a future launch mission.
- Added district-wide Mental Health Resources to its funding priorities to ensure students' wellness needs are met beyond academics.



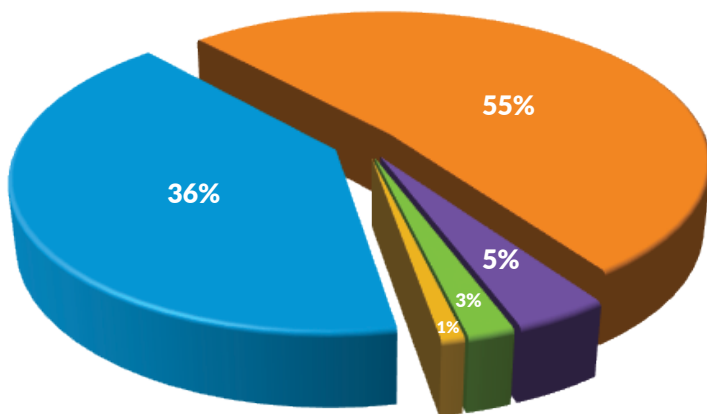

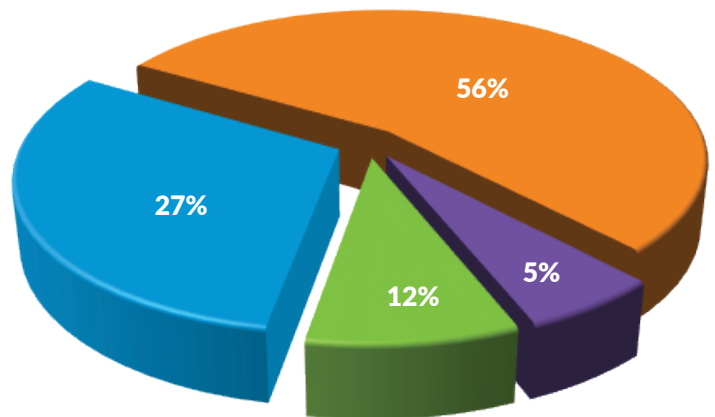
**TOTAL INCOME: \$7,715,978**

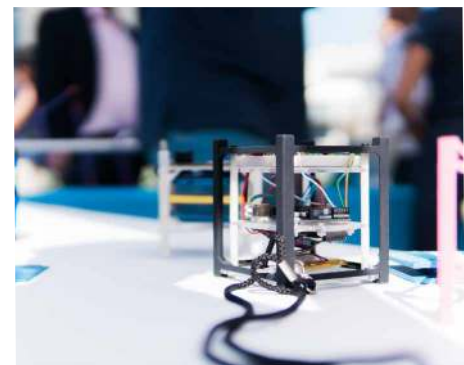
## INNOVATION IN ACTION

### *Irvine CubeSat Continues To Reach New Heights*

For the second year in a row, the Irvine CubeSat STEM Program was selected as one of only 34 small satellites nationwide to participate in NASA's CubeSat Launch Initiative and fly on an upcoming mission. IRVINE03 is the only high school mission chosen this year by NASA to participate in this prestigious program, alongside world class universities and research centers.

The Irvine CubeSat STEM Program is uniting the City of Irvine's public high schools in partnership with industry experts to assemble, test, and launch a CubeSat spacecraft, a type of miniaturized satellite for space research. IPSF is proud to be the founding partner, of this groundbreaking program designed to spark student interest in STEM disciplines as well as strengthen Orange County's future workforce.

This unbelievable opportunity validates the hard work and dedication of the students, teachers, and all of the partners involved. The Irvine CubeSat STEM Program is a true testament to what can be accomplished through the collaboration of industry experts, corporate partners, and public education. These students are setting an example for young people around the world that anything is possible, and we are excited to be part of making their dreams become a reality.



## YOUR DONATIONS AT WORK

### *When Children Serve, They Learn*

Empowering students to take action and recognize the impact that they can make, regardless of their age, can be a powerful character building experience. For the last three years, IPSF has provided the Serve & Learn course as part of the Summer Enrichment Academy (SEA). This class provides students with the opportunity to learn about how they can serve their community, and see the results!

The course is designed to be student-driven, so that they would connect with the projects and causes on a personal level. "My biggest hope is that the students were able to realize that they can make a difference in the world and that it doesn't matter that they are young or only one person, they can be the spark to ignite future change!" explains Ms. Belzer, Serve & Learn instructor.

Throughout the course, students participated in a number of activities including helping the custodial team pick up trash around the school, making dog toys and fleece blankets to donate to a local animal shelter, writing letters to the elderly at a local nursing home, and making origami for veterans, military, and first responders.

Through classes like Serve & Learn, students are presented with experiences that will have a lasting impact. One student said it best: "We are in charge of making sure the future knows how to help. If one person stops helping, the cycle also stops."
